**Directions**

From I-35, take Exit 233 (Riverside Drive) to Riverside. Turn west on Riverside, going west for 1+ miles. Turn left onto Barton Springs Road and travel for 0.5 miles. Turn left onto Dawson at traffic light, travel for 0.15 mile. The Elks Lodge is on the hill on the right, 700 Dawson Road.

From west US 290/71, take Lamar Blvd. exit toward Loop 360/Capitol of Texas Highway/Manchaca Road. Keep left at the fork (Lamar) following the signs for Lamar Blvd/TX 343 Loop. Merge onto South Lamar Blvd. Continue north on Lamar for 3+ miles. Turn right at Barton Springs Road. Turn right at the light after the railway underpass onto Dawson Road, travel for 0.15 mile. The Elks Lodge is on the hill on the right, 700 Dawson Road.

**LOCATION:** Start/Finish is at The Elks Lodge, 700 Dawson Road; Austin, Texas 78704.

**START / FINISH TIMES:** Start between 8:00 a.m. and 12:00 noon; finish by 3:00 p.m.

**ROUTE:** The 10k walk is flat, rated "2", and will be on paved roads and hiking trails. A small part of the walk is through wooded creek bottom. Strollers or wheelchairs are not advised, but an alternate street route is provided. There will be a 5km route. Participants will be provided with written instructions for the route. Restrooms are located at the Start/Finish.

**AWARDS:** "B" awards from previous walks will be available. Children under 12 are eligible for a free "B" award of their choice.

**EVENT CONDITIONS:** The event will be held regardless of weather conditions. All participants must carry a Start Card. Walk route twice on same start card for additional distance credit. Events are noncompetitive. Walk, jog, or run at your own pace. Pets are allowed on the walk (not in buildings), but must be on a leash at all times and waste must be picked up.

**ELIGIBILITY:** Everyone is welcome. These events are open to all, regardless of age, sex, creed, race or nationality. An adult must accompany children under age 12.

**IVV CREDIT:** This event is sanctioned by the American Volkssport Association (AVA), a member of the International Federation of Popular Sports (IVV) and counts toward acquisition of IVV Achievement Awards. IVV books may be purchased at the event for \$5.00.

**REFRESHMENTS:** Water, coffee, and snacks will be available at the Start/Finish. There will be water at checkpoints.
